The freezing point of urine is influenced by diet, liquids, exercise and elimination through other channels, as emesis, diarrheas, perspiration,, etc. CRYOSCOFY OF THE BLOOD. The cryoscopic examination of the blood gives us more valuable information, because it has been found that the freezing point of normal blood is practically constant, varying from--0.55 to--0.57 C, the average being--0.56 C. Any marked change in the freezing point of the blood at once tells us that there is something wrong, and that we must look, first of all to the functional activity of the kidneys, since it has been found that interference with the proper excretory function of the kidneys causes a concentration of the blood, hence a lowering of its freezing point. The amount of blood required for determining the freezing point is about 10 cc, and is readily obtained by puncturing one of the larger veins in the forearm. The skin is washed with soap and water, alcohol and ether, the veins constricted above, and the needle of a Luer syringe is plunged under the skin, as in giving a hypodermic, and then introduced into the vein. Gradual suction is used in drawing the blood by slowly withdrawing the piston. When the required amount is obtained (10 or 12 cc.) the constrictor is removed, the needle quickly withdrawn, and gentle pressure made over the point of entrance. This is later sealed with collodion. It causes no inconvenience to the patient and may be done painlessly by using a little ethyl bromide or chloride spray. In over 300 punctures, I have not met with a single accident or objection from the patient. The w...
